### *Self-Reflection*

Understand your strengths and weaknesses to determine areas of growth. Identify goals for personal and professional development.

### *Timeline*

### *Research Mentors*

Seek industry professionals in your desired field that aligns with your goals. Utilize resources such as company websites, professional associations, and networking events.

### *Prepare Outreach*

Be prepared to illustrate your skills, knowledge, and goals. Craft a compelling message that explains why you are seeking mentorship and why you think the mentor would be a good fit.

### *Outreach*

Don't limit yourself to one mentor; ask multiple professionals to increase your chance of finding a good fit. Use appropriate and varied mediums to deliver your message: email, phone call, direct messaging, etc.

### *Leverage Resources*

Utilize [American Job Center](#) at YC to polish your resume, portfolio, and interview skills.

### *Be Proactive*

Follow up with potential mentors. Be proactive in scheduling meetings. Be punctual, prepared, and focused with your communication. Be respectful of time constraints. Show gratitude.

### *HELPFUL TIPS:*

- Be patient and persistent. Finding a mentor can take time.
- Be respectful. Understand that mentors, like you, have their own commitments.
- Show gratitude for their time.
- Be proactive and remain engaged in the process.
